Who is concerned?



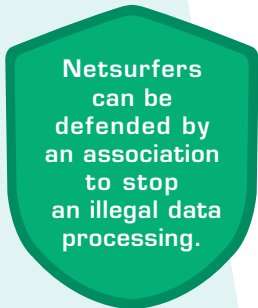
What does it mean?

For the firm



- ✓ Have a written, clear and explicit agreement from the netsurfer before the processing of personal data;

- ✓ To be sure that minors have the parental consent before the subscription to a social network.



For the surfer



- ✓ The right to oblivion to obtain the withdrawal of personal data when an invasion of privacy occurs;

- ✓ The right to data portability, for the data transfert from a system to another;

- ✓ The right of information when a data hacking occurs.

What are the risks?

If the General Data Protection Regulation is flouted, we carry a penalty up to:

4% Global Turnover
For the legal person

5 years IMPRISONMENT
For the natural person
